### FEEDBACK FROM SURVEYS

Thank you to everyone who completed the recent survey. The Parish Council and I discussed your feedback at our September meeting, and we will continue to process your ideas and suggestions going forward.

Overall, the feedback on the plan to increase the cooperation between our offices at St. Mary of the Woods and St. Patrick was very positive. The average level of support was 4.2 out of 5 from St. Mary of the Woods parishioners and 4.7 from St. Patrick parishioners. After taking account of the support from parishioners and the Parish Council, I have approved the plan.

The greatest benefit I see to this plan is that our offices will be working together as one to serve our parishes rather than working as two separate offices. This will enable our staff to have greater flexibility in sharing responsibilities, and I will be able to manage the offices more efficiently. That will enable me to dedicate more time to non-administrative ministry for our parishes.


We plan to begin cross-training staff on Tuesdays in November. Depending on how quickly the training goes, the full implementation will take place either in December or by January 1st at the latest. At that time, the office at St. Mary of the Woods will be open on Mondays and Fridays from 8:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. The office at St. Patrick will be open from Monday-Thursday, 9:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Parishioners can call either office if they need assistance since our staff will be serving both parishes. If we need to make adjustments to fine-tune the plan, or if something isn't working out, we will adapt accordingly.

The question was raised as to why there are more office hours at St. Patrick. Our staff has to be in the same place at the same time for a portion of the week for them to work together cohesively. The office at St. Patrick is more geographically central for me given my travel routes between the parishes in Logan and Champaign Counties. However, I will spend time at both locations and will continue to be available to schedule appointments with parishioners as I currently do.

I know that structural changes like this can cause anxiety for parishioners and concerns about the future. However, it is important that we make adjustments to the current reality to best position our parishes to flourish. Ultimately, we place our trust in the power of God to bless and make fruitful the work we undertake. Know that I am praying for all of you and your intentions. Father Shawn Landenwitch

# LOGAN COUNTY PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

Summary:

Parish Council met Tuesday, September 17th at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Joseph Room at SMOW with 10 of the 12 members present. Fr. Shawn led us in opening prayer and there were no parishioners present to address the council.

The results of the feedback on a combined office for the Logan County parishes were reviewed. St. Patrick's parishioners supported the change 4.7 out of 5 and St. Mary of the Woods parishioners supported the change with a 4.3 out of 5. Many commented that they agree with the changes to free Father Shawn's time to minister to the parishioners. After some cross training and office layout changes, Father Shawn hoped to have full implementation by early January 2025.


To complete a request from the Beacons of Light, the Parish Leadership Team (Fr. Shawn, Fr. Jared, Ashley Roberts, and Seminarian Benjamin) created a parish vision statement for our family of parishes. It was inspired by the first and second joyful mysteries of our Blessed Mother's Rosary. "Following in the footsteps of Our Lady, we will welcome and adore the abiding presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and bring Him with joy to those we encounter." Pat Tynan moved to accept the parish vision statement and a second was given by Barb Ternasky with unanimous approval.

Holy Family Hall restroom renovations are moving forward with a goal to provide appropriately sized restroom facilities for adults while still accommodating children. The plan is to add handicap accessible stalls in both restrooms, new toilets, stall dividers, flooring, counters, and fixtures. This project is funded through a generous donation and other funds earmarked for this purpose. A motion to accept the updates was given by Renee Winner and Barb Ternasky seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

Father Shawn commented that RCIA is larger than previous years with 14 individuals seeking initiation plus a number of Catholics sitting in to learn more about the Catholic Church.

Father gave us his blessing and the meeting concluded at 8:10 p.m.
